Treasurer's Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Health insurance money was credited - no monetary payout this month - Bruce Krog is paying on time. • Park - \$2923.40 (\$2,200 was transferred from the township to cover expenses while awaiting grant money) • Road & Bridge - \$207,425.61 • Township - \$169,242.55 	Trustee Jablonski motioned to approve with a second by Trustee Nomellini. Approved – 4 ayes 0 nays

Highway Commissioner's Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Resurfacing has been completed - final cost was \$181,098.29. • Crack filling has been completed - final cost was \$25,228.80. • Pavement striping has been completed - cost was \$8,997.30. They will have to come back to do Crawford Rd. Dittman Rd. There will be an additional bill for the 1400 ft. remaining. • First 100 tons of salt has been ordered and it is expected to be delivered next week. There is still some left from last season. • The back 5 acres of the park were mowed. • Larry saved the R&B approximately \$350 by welding the runners on two mowers and another approximate \$400 by rebuilding the gear box on the 1995 International.
